Parent Permission to join several Web 2.0 multimedia sites

This course is about creating and sharing multimedia projects across the Internet. The term Web 2.0 refers to sites where users create the content -- like Youtube and Flickr. Students must have their own email address and permission to join web services used in class. A list of sites used in this class is available at www.mrgibbs.com/excel

If your child does not have a email address, one must be created, or the parent/guardian will have to join the required sites and then provide login and password to the student.

Because some student-created class content will be published publically on the Internet, students must adhere to strict etiquette guidelines.

Participation Rules:

- Students are to never share personal information that would identify them to the general public beyond the local community and school where they are already known. No last names, no addresses, no specific local references will be shared.
- Signing this form permits students in this particular class to upload each other's pictures and innocent family photos as a mutual exchange. Names and faces cannot be posted together unless it is a large group photo and names cannot be matched to faces.
- No inappropriate content will be tolerated. Common sense should tell you what is appropriate and what is not. If you are unsure of your content, clear it with the teacher first. Students engaging in posting inappropriate will be dropped from the class.
